# RtI Universal Screening

- What is Universal Screening?
  - Universal Screening is a quick and efficient way to assess students and identify students who may be at risk in reading or math. Universal Screening takes place three times a year (Fall, Winter, and Spring)
- What is done with the results?
  - The results are analyzed by teachers and administrators. If a student is at risk an intervention plan would be developed and implemented.

# What is an Intervention?

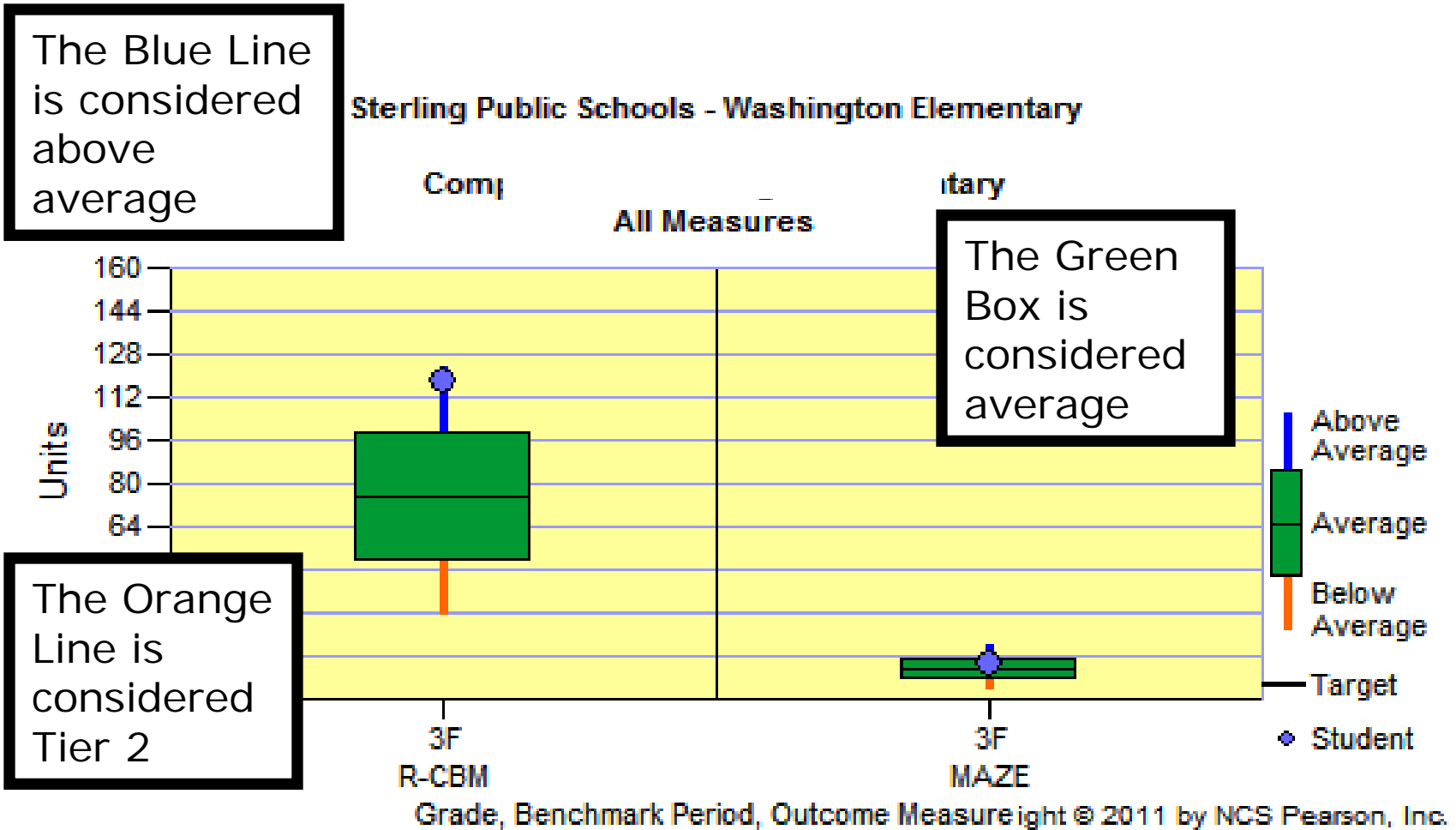
- Once a student is identified as at risk and the team has decided on an intervention plan, the student will receive additional instruction (intervention) in the area they are at risk.
  - For example, a 1<sup>st</sup> grade student was screened and is at risk in phonics. This student would attend a phonics intervention in addition to their regular Reading class. This student would be monitored frequently to evaluate the effectiveness of the intervention.

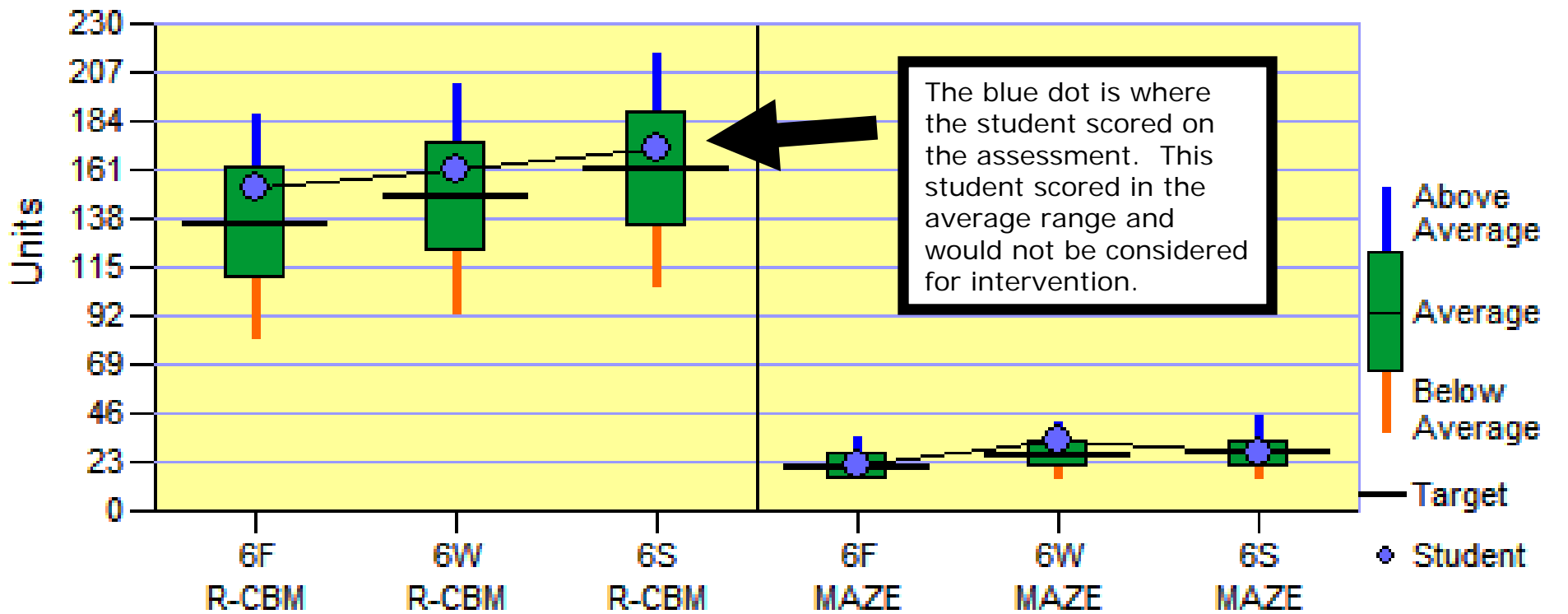

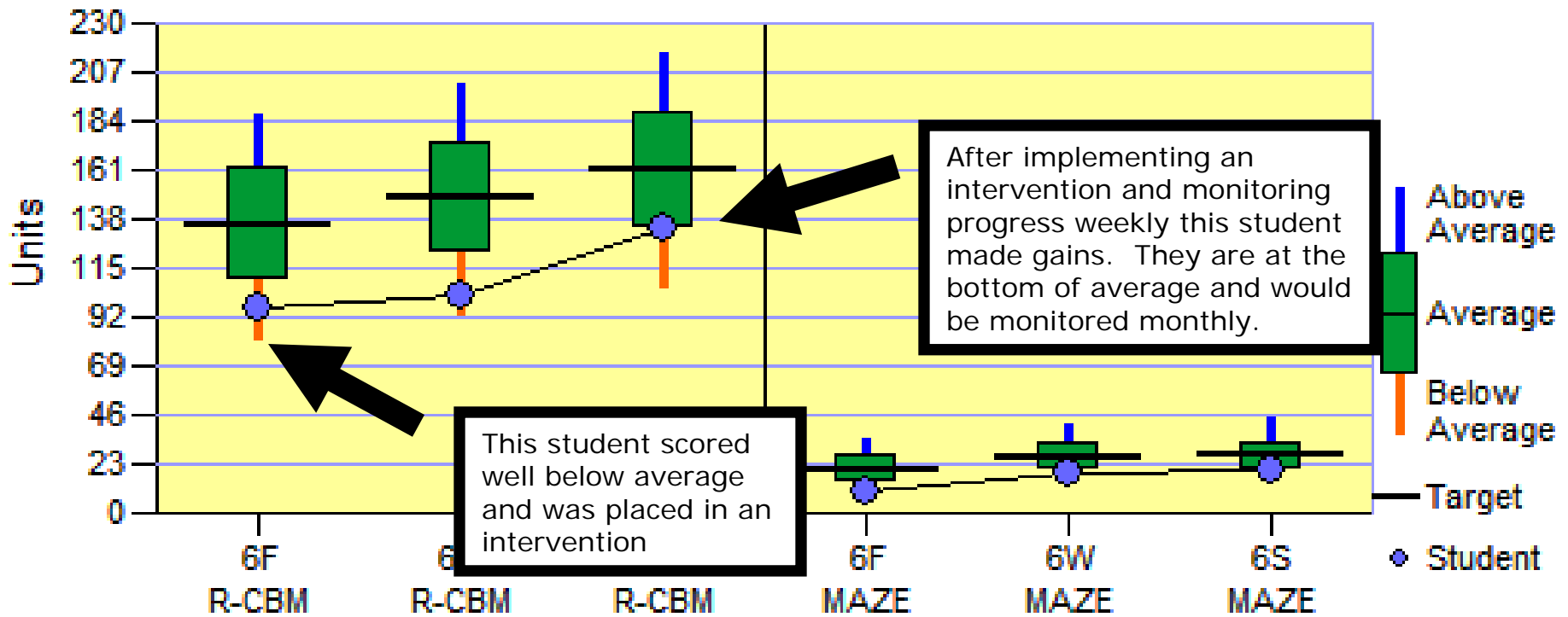
