We are "those left behind." Victims of a tragedy that we could not foresee but feel responsibility for, and for which there is no closure.

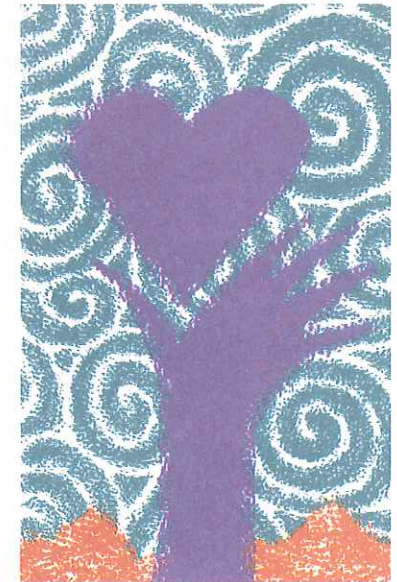
We are parents, spouses, siblings, children, relatives, partners, companions and friends of one who has completed suicide.
