Use 10 digit cell number

To have notifications regarding books which are due or overdue sent to your cell phone,

1. Go to the library website > **Book/Ebook Catalog**
2. Click on “My Account” and login:
  - a. *User ID*: ID number from your ID card
  - b. *Password*: month and day - NOT year- of your birth – 4 digits.  
ie: July 4 would be 0704)
  - c. Change the email address using the protocol above.

Notifications will be sent directly to your phone.
